Pricing Guidelines

All pricing includes the cost of take-home pain medication for each animal. It is a state requirement that all animals who receive surgery have proof of current rabies vaccination. If you cannot provide proof of rabies vaccination, All Creatures Veterinary Hospital can administer it for an additional cost (see bottom of form).

All payments must be made in advance prior to surgery. We DO NOT accept checks. Payments must either be cash or debit/credit card.

**Additional costs may apply for animals that are in heat, pregnant, overweight, or require a plastic e-collar.*

CATS:

**Pregnant, in heat, or overweight cats (at veterinarian's discretion), will receive an additional fee of \$10*

DOGS (up to 40 lbs):

Neuter \$50	\$45	\$40
Spay \$70	\$65	\$60

DOGS (41 lbs – 79 lbs):

Neuter (up to 79+ lbs)	\$75	\$70	\$65

DOGS - Spay Only (80 lbs – 100+ lbs):

Income Level 1	Income Level 2	Income Level 3
Spay \$105	\$100	\$95

Pregnant, in heat, or overweight dogs (at veterinarian's discretion) will receive an additional fee of \$25

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

- Rabies Vaccination: \$10
- Umbilical Hernia Repair: \$25
- Plastic e-collar: \$8 (mandatory for dogs)

**All pets will receive a rabies vaccination unless proof of current rabies vaccination is provided.*
